1. The offer of admission is open between 23:06:2010 and 25:06:2010. Admission shall remain open between 10.00 a.m and 1.00 p.m. The fees must be deposited up to 1.00 p.m on 25:06:2010 after which the right of admission shall be forfeited.
2. The basis of calculation of %age of marks is indicated with each course.
3. At the time of admission, the applicants shall be required to produce in original alongwith one set of self-attested photocopies (both sides) of the following documents:
 - Class X Board Examination Certificate
 - Class X marks-sheet
 - Class XII marks-sheet
 - Class XII Provisional Certificate
 - Character Certificate (**recent**)
 - SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in candidate's own name)
 - Transfer Certificate from school/college as well as Migration Certificate from Board/University are required from those students who have passed from outside Delhi
 - Xerox copy of the Passport (for foreign students only)

One passport-size photograph to be affixed on the Admission Form.

One passport size photograph of either of the parent should be affixed on the admission form

The procedure of admission is printed at the back of the requisition slip to be obtained from the Admission Committee.

1. B.A.

- (a) The percentage of marks shall be calculated on the basis of four best subjects including one or at the most two languages (one core + one elective).
- (b) The cut-off percentage shall be 4% higher for those who are including one of the following subjects among their best four subjects:

Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship, Environmental Education/Science/Studies, Fashion Studies, Engineering Drawing, Fine Arts, Agriculture and Web & Multimedia Technology.
- (c) The cut-off percentage shall be 5% higher for those who are including one of the vocational subjects in their best four subjects.

2. **B. COM.**

The percentage of marks shall be calculated on the basis of one language and three best elective subjects.

- (i) 87% and above in the aggregate with Commerce subjects.
(Any three of Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy and Mathematics/
Business Mathematics).
- (ii) 91% and above in aggregate from Science & Humanities stream.
- (iii) 96% and above in aggregate from any streams with one vocational subject.

5% relaxation in the cut-off percentage is applicable to candidates offering Bengali/Urdu and the candidate should have passed Bengali/Urdu in class X/XII

3. **B. COM (HONS.)**

The percentage of marks shall be calculated on the basis of one language plus three best elective subjects. Students should have passed Mathematics/Business Mathematics at the Class XII examination.

- (i) 87% and above in the aggregate with Commerce subjects
(Any three of Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy and
Mathematics/Business Mathematics)
- (ii) 91% and above in aggregate from Science/Humanities stream.

The marks of Computer Sc. will be counted in full for category (ii).

- (iii) 96% and above in the aggregate from other streams with one
academic/vocational subject whose marks will be counted in full.

4. **B.Sc.Physical Sciences** - (PHY,CHEM/COM.SC, MATHS) - 68% and above.

B.Sc.Life Sciences - (PHY,CHEM,BIO/BIO-TECH.) - 68% and above.

5. **B. Sc. (HONS.)**

- 1. BOTANY - (PHY,CHEM,BIO/BIO-TECH.) - 70% and above.
- 2. CHEMISTRY - (PHY,CHEM,MATH) - 70% and above.
- 3. ELECTRONICS - (PHY,MATH) - 83% and above.
- 4. ZOOLOGY - (PHY,CHEM,BIO/BIO-TECH.) - 70% and above.

6. **B.Sc. (Hons.) Maths**

- 1. 75% in PCM with 80% and above in Mathematics
- 2. 78% in aggregate including one language for Humanities Stream with 80%

7. B. A (HONS.)

The percentage of marks for all Honours courses shall be calculated on the basis of four best subjects including one language.

The cut-off shall be 5% higher for those who are including one of the following subjects among their best four subjects:

Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship, Bio-Technology, Web & Multimedia Tech., Engineering Drawing, Fine Arts, Environmental Sc., Environmental Studies, Environmental Education & Agriculture.

1. ARABIC:

- (i) 55% and above in the aggregate.
The candidate should have passed either of Arabic/Persian/Urdu in Class X & XII.

2. BENGALI:

- (i) All eligible candidates who have passed Bengali in Class X or XII.

3. ECONOMICS:

- (i) 85% and above in the aggregate from Humanities/Science stream with Mathematics/Business Mathematics/Economics.
(ii) 88% and above in the aggregate from Commerce stream with Mathematics/Business Mathematics.

4. ENGLISH:

Students who have secured 72% and above in CATE are eligible for admission to B.A. (H) English course

5. HINDI:

- (i) 64% and above in aggregate with 70% in Hindi Core/65% in Hindi Elective.

6. HISTORY:

- (i) 72% and above in aggregate in Humanities with History.
(ii) 74% and above in aggregate in Humanities without History.
(iii) 76% and above in aggregate from Science/Commerce streams.

7. PERSIAN:

All eligible candidates who have passed either of Arabic/Persian/Urdu in Class X & XII.

9. **PHILOSOPHY:**

61% and above in the aggregate and 65% or more in English.

10. **POLITICAL SCIENCE:**

- (i) 73% and above in the aggregate in Humanities.
- (ii) 75% and above in aggregate from Science stream.
- (iii) 79% and above in aggregate from Commerce stream

11. **PSYCHOLOGY:**

- (i) 81% and above in the aggregate with Psychology.
- (ii) 83% and above in the aggregate without Psychology (all stream).

12. **SANSKRIT:**

- (i) 51% and above in aggregate and 55% in Sanskrit in Class XII.
- (ii) 53% and above in the aggregate and 60% in Sanskrit in Class X. (For those who have not studied Sanskrit in Class XII).

13. **URDU:**

- (i) 61% and above in the aggregate and 60% in Urdu Elective.
- (ii) 61% and above in the aggregate and 62% in Urdu Core.
The candidate should have passed Urdu in Class X & XII.

NOTE :

1. Compartment cases shall be considered on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in three subjects as per the rules already indicated against each course and adding 33% marks in the subject in which he/she has been placed in compartment. If in this process the candidate reaches the cut-off percentage point, provisional admission shall be granted. However, candidates with compartment will not be considered for admission to B.Sc. (Hons.) courses.
2. Students seeking admission on the basis of sports, should read the notice already placed on the Notice Board.
3. A small number of seats not exceeding 10 are reserved for those who have talent in ECA (Arts & Culture/Debating). The trials for the same will be held on July 03, 2010 at 10:30 a.m. in the College Auditorium.
